C I R C U L A R

The fodder Scheme for release of Agriculture connections for raising fodder was introduced by Erstwhile RSEB vide Order No. RSEB: Dy. CE (RE-1/LD) D. 2544 dated 14.12.99 (REA-176). In the first instance this Scheme was made applicable for normal agricultural applicants registered up to 13.12.99. Application under this Scheme were receivable up to 31.12.99 and connections were required to be released up to 31.3.2000. It was prescribed in the said order that for such connections in Urban area tariff @ 140 Paise/Unit and in the rural area flat rate @ Rs. 120/- per HP/Month was prescribed to be charged. This Scheme was further extended for a specific period of two months vide order No. RSEB: Dy. CE: RE(S&I-SEC.): F. 1201: D. 3131 dated 10.3.2000 (REA-192). Where new application for raising fodder were receivable up to 9.5.2000.

Later on the Erstwhile RSEB vide order No. RSEB: Dy. CE (RE) Sec. 9: D. 51 dated 22.6.2000 (REA-207) at para 13 had introduced on special scheme which was purely optional for the existing agricultural applicants opting for out of priority connections. Where the rate of tariff was Rs 120/- per HP/Month under Flat Rate.

The operation of para 13 of the RSEB order dated 22.6.2000 prescribing higher tariff for special category of connections to agriculturists in general was stayed by the Rajasthan State Electricity Regulatory Commission vide order dated 1.9.2000.

Doubts have been received from the various field officers in light of the above mentioned orders and the order dated 1.9.2000 of RERC, the replies to the clarifications sought are as under:-

1) Whether the applications registered under order dated 14.12.99 (1st. Phase) and extended order dated 10.3.2000 (2nd. Phase) and connections released now tariff as prescribed in the order dated 14.12.99 can be applied or not.	Yes, the tariff prescribed in the order dated 14.12.99 is to be applied.
11) Whether the field officers should continue to accept the new applications under 'special Category' of Agriculture connections.	N O

- iii) What tariff is to be applied:- As already indicated on the Special Category of Agriculture connection. at item (1) above.
- iv) Since the tariff for Special:- Demand Notices should be issued only for Category of connections has been stayed, whether we should issue the demand notices/ those applications for release connections for applications accepted/registered after 22.6.2000. connections for fodder which were received up to 31.12.1999 in terms of order dated 14.12.99 and up to 9.5.2000 in terms of the order RE-192 Only.

All the filed officers shall ensure compliance of these instructions accordingly.
