ORDER

Sub: Incentive in tariff to Large Industrial consumers.

With a view to encourage growth in industrial consumption by large industrial consumers an incentive scheme for granting concessions in tariff to large industrial consumers causing higher consumption is introduced duly approved by RERC. Salient points of the incentive scheme are given hereunder:-

1. Large industrial consumers whose consumption is at least 2.5% more than the consumption of base year i.e. financial year 2002-03, the additional power drawn by the said consumer shall be supplied at concessional rate(s) hereinafter mentioned.
2. The incentive to consumers would be regulated as under:-
 - a) Upto 50% Load Factor: 10% rebate on energy charges for excess units consumed above the base year i.e. FY 2002-03.
 - b) More than 50% Load Factor: 15% rebate on energy charges for excess units consumed above the base year i.e. FY 2002-03.
3. For the purpose of calculations of average monthly consumption of the base year 2002-03, the month in which the consumer had caused consumption below minimum would not be taken into account. Load factor of consumer will be considered for the Base Year i.e. FY 2002-03.
4. The incentive by way of rebate shall be applicable on consumption of electricity caused from 1st April, 03 to 31st March, 2004.
5. The concession for higher consumption would be allowed quarterly subject to adjustment at the end of each quarter and final adjustment at the end of the year based on cumulative consumption.
6. For grant of incentive under this scheme, the consumer should have no arrear outstanding against them.
7. The incentive shall not be admissible to consumer who have reduced their contract demand during the year 2003-04.
8. Connection of Railway Traction and PHED shall not be eligible for grant of concession as per this scheme.
9. New consumers, who have not completed 12 months operation by 31st March, 2003, shall not be eligible for this scheme.
10. In the case of seasonal industry, the average consumption of season months for the base year is to be taken for calculation of incentive which shall be allowed on the excess consumption in the seasonal months. While calculating the average monthly consumption in such cases, the month in which the billed amount had been below minimum amount would be excluded.

In order to elaborate the matter following illustration is given:

For consumer whose average monthly consumption has been 100 units/month during the financial year 2002-03 and in the current year if the consumption in the first quarter of the year 2003-04 is more than 307.5 units (2.5% per month), he would be eligible for grant of incentive.

Suppose consumer has consumed a total 330 units in the first quarter of the financial year 2003-04, a rebate of 10% or 15% depending upon the load factor of the consumer shall be allowed for additional 30 units.

Aforesaid scheme shall be applicable on the consumption of electricity from 1st April, 2003 to 31st March,2004.
