Sub:- Scheme for grant of medical concessions to Pensioners of Company.

The Board of Rajasthan Rajya Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Ltd, in its 12th meeting held on 9.5.2001 has decided to make the following amendments in the Pensioners Medical Concessions Scheme, namely ;

In the said scheme ;

I. The existing para 2(v) shall be substituted by the following;

"(v) 'Family' means pensioner's wife (not more than one)/ husband, if wholly dependant upon the pensioner. Wife/husband will be regarded as wholly dependant upon the pensioner if she/he normally resides with the pensioner and the total monthly income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 500/- per month. In case pensioner was having a son or unmarried daughter suffering from any disorder or disability of mind or is physically crippled or disabled so as to render him or her unable to earn a living will be regarded as member of family for the purpose of medical facility available in the Scheme."

II. The following shall be inserted as 'CLARIFICATION' below Sub-para (ii) (c) of Para 3 :

"CLARIFICATION":

Reimbursement of the charges paid for various pathological, Bacteriological, radiological tests, X-Ray, etc. shall be regulated as under :

- (i) For the tests got done in the Government hospital, actual charges paid shall be reimbursable.
- (ii) In case of non-availability of facility at a particular time, if the tests got done from a private agency after obtaining NAC from the Govt. hospital, the reimbursement in such case shall be admissible to the extent it would have been admissible if the tests got done in the Govt. hospital.
- (iii) In case the facility is not available at all and the test got done from a private agency after obtaining NAC from the Government hospital, 60% of the charges paid for such test shall be reimbursable.

III. The existing clarification appearing below sub-para(ii)(f) of para 3 shall be substituted by the following :

"CLARIFICATION"

The scale of reimbursement of the cost of medicines to the pensioners shall be regulated as under :-

- (i) Reimbursement of the cost of medicines purchased from the authorised shops be allowed upto Rs. 3000/- only in a financial year to each pensioner provided that this cost ceiling shall not be applicable to those pensioners who have attained the age of 75 yrs or above if they furnish documentary proof of age.

Provided further that in case of pensioners suffering from chronic disease like Cancer, T.B., Heart disease and insulin dependant diabetes, the cost ceiling shall be Rs. 10,000/- in a financial year.

ii) Jurisdiction Level Committee, as constituted for the purpose, may relax this general limit of Rs. 3000/- per annum by another Rs. 22000/- per annum in case of each pensioner. The Jurisdiction Level Committee shall be comprised of the following :

(a) At field offices :

- 1. Chief Engineer President.
- 2. A representative of the pensioners to be nominated by Chief Engineer. Member.
- 3. Accounts Officer. Member Secretary.

(b) At Company Head Quarter :

- 1. Concerned JDP/DEP President.
- 2. A representative of the pensioners to be nominated by the CMD. Member.
- 3. Concerned Accounts Officer. Member Secretary.

Note : The above Committee while relaxing the limit of Rs.5000/- per annum and above may obtain second medical opinion after scrutiny of the cases where felt necessary.

iii) Cases of pensioners requiring medicines costing more than Rs. 25,000/- in a year be recommended by the Jurisdiction Level Committee to the Sub-Committee of the Company comprising of the following :-

- 1. Secretary(Admn.)RVPN President.
- 2. Chief Personnel Officer-Member. Jaipur Discom.
- 3. C.A.O.(P&F),RVPN Member Secretary.

Note : Consultation with PMHO/CMHO of the Government Hospital/Dispensary may be done if felt necessary by the above committee."

IV. After existing sub-para (g) of Para 3, the following new sub-para shall be inserted :

"(h) The cost of Intra-ocular lens shall be reimbursed @ 50% of the actual cost of Intra-Ocular Lens or Rs. 1600/- whichever is less to the Pensioners provided that it is certified by the Head of Eye Department of the Government Hospital that free lens is not available in the Hospital and implantation of the same is essential in the Cataract Eye operation of the Pensioners."

V. The existing 'Note' appearing below para 3(a) shall be substituted by the following :

"Note Notwithstanding anything contained in para 3(A) & 3(D) of the Scheme, in the cases where the pensioners or the member of his family as defined in sub para (v) of para 2 of the Scheme who is referred for treatment in a hospital/institution outside the State recognised by the State Government due to lack of facility in a Government hospital in Rajasthan the pensioner or the member of his family, as the case may be, can take treatment in any private hospital

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in Rajasthan where such facility exists, if he so wishes. The reimbursement of medical attendance and treatment in such bases shall be admissible to the extent it would have been admissible under the provisions of para 3(A) or 3(B) of the Scheme, as the case may be, for treatment outside the State applicable from time to time.

VI. The words & punctuation "bypass surgery," appearing in para 3(B) shall be deleted.

VIII. After existing para 3(C), the following new para 3(D) shall be inserted :

"3(D) Treatment of heart ailment in recognised hospital outside the State (with or without recommendation of the Medical Board) :

(a) In case it is recommended by the Medical Board that bypass surgery for heart is indicated, the pensioner can get himself operated in any of the hospitals recognised by the Medical Board for this purpose. Such pensioner may be allowed 80% of hospital expenses limited to Rs. 56,000/- being 80% of General Ward charges of All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi.

(b) In case a pensioner undergoes bypass surgery for heart (Cardio Thoracic surgery) in any recognised hospital outside the state in emergent circumstances without any recommendation of the Medical Board, he may be allowed 80% of hospital expenses limited to Rs. 56,000/- i.e. 80% of General Ward charges of AIIMS, New Delhi provided that he submits a Certificate from a Cardiologist who holds a degree of D.M. in Cardiology or MCh in Cardio Thoracic Surgery stating that pensioner's condition was such that immediate treatment was essential.

(c) When a pensioner undergoes bypass surgery for heart in S.N.S. Hospital, Jaipur or any other Government hospital in Rajasthan he may be allowed actual hospital expenses or Rs. 1.20 lac, whichever is less.

VIII. The existing words and figures "Rs. 25/-" appearing in item No. (iv) of para 10 shall be substituted by the words and figures "Rs. 50/-".

IX. The following shall be inserted as item No.(v) below the existing item No. (iv) of para 10:

"(v) It will be obligatory for every pensioner either to get the identify card (Form PMCF-2) renewed every year on the payment of Rs. 50/- or he may make payment of Rs. 1000/- in respect of pensioner whose last pay drawn at the time of retirement was upto Rs. 10,000/- and Rs. 2000/- in respect of pensioner whose last pay drawn at the time of retirement was above Rs. 10,000/- as one time renewal fee for the identity card. The Accounts Officer concerned shall make an entry to this effect in office record that the pensioner has deposited Rs.1000/- or Rs. 2000/-, as the case may be, as one time renewal fee of the identity card and shall sign below the renewal order. The seal of one time renewal fee shall be affixed on the new identity cards which may be issued from time to time. The one time renewal fee which shall be in addition to the price of the card, shall be credited to the fund. The Accounts Officer concerned shall maintain proper account of one time renewal fee received."

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The existing ~~para~~ 10(A) shall be substituted by the following :-

\*10(A)(i) The Pensioners/Family Pensioner can avail medical facility under Allopathic and Ayurvedic both a system of treatment under the scheme and no option would be necessary. (ii) The terms and conditions for reimbursement of expenses incurred by a Pensioner of Company on account of medical attendance and treatment under Ayurved shall be as per terms and conditions applicable from time to time for serving employees of the Company.

These amendments shall be effective from 9.05.2001.

The Board of Directors further decided to authorise the Chairman & Managing Director of RVPN for adopting Government orders/Circulars in regard to Pensioners Medical Concession Scheme, in future.
