**ORDER - 84**

**Sub :-** Grant of Dearness Allowance to AVVNL, employees.

In exercise of the Powers conferred under erstwhile RSEB's Order No. RSEB/F&R/F16(2)(iii)/D35 Dt. 15<sup>th</sup> June, 1988 read with AVVNL, Order No. AVVNL/D.02 Dated 27.7.2000 and also as approved in CMD's Co-ordination committee meeting held on 10.10.03, the Chairman & Managing Director is pleased to order that the existing rate of Dearness Allowance to the employees of the AVVNL under order No. AVVNL/CAO/F&R/F1(3)/D 1657 Dt. 21.2.2003 shall be revised from 52% to 55% of pay per month w.e.f. 1.1.2003 & further from 55% to 59% w.e.f. 1.7.2003.

2. The term "Pay" for the purpose of calculation of Dearness Allowance shall be the pay as defined in Regulation 3 (XVIII)(a) of Employees Service Regulation drawn in the Revised pay scales prescribed vide erstwhile RSEB's Order No. RSEB/F&R/F46(21)(iii)/ D11 Dt. 24.2.98 as amended from time to time & shall not include any other type (s) of pay like special pay or personal pay etc. In the case of those employees who opt to retain the existing Scale of pay, it will include, in addition to pay in the pre-revised scale, Dearness Allowance & interim relief appropriate to that pay admissible under orders in existence on 1.1.96.
3. The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving fractions of 50 paise & above may be rounded off to the next higher rupee and fractions of less than 50 paise may be ignored.
4. The amount of arrears of Dearness Allowance on account of increase from 52% to 55% for the period of 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2003 to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2003 will be paid as follows:-

- (a) In respect of employees drawing basic pay up to Rs. 10500/- per month (Rs. 3500/- per month for those employees who opt to retain the existing scale of pay), the arrears may be paid in cash in three installments as mentioned below.

<u>Period</u>	<u>To be paid in</u>
<b>1.1.2003 to 31.3.2003</b>	<b>December 2003 (After 15<sup>th</sup>)</b>
<b>1.4.2003 to 30.6.2003</b>	<b>January 2004 (After 15<sup>th</sup>)</b>
<b>1.7.2003 to 30.9.2003</b>	<b>February 2004 (After 15<sup>th</sup>)</b>

- (b) In respect of employees drawing basic pay above Rs. 10500/- per month, the arrears may be credited to their GPF Account or invested in PPF/NSC as per authorisation in 3 (three) installments as indicated at (a) above.
- (c) The payment of Dearness Allowance at increased rate of 55% for the month Oct. 2003 (Provided on 1.11.2003) and onwards shall be paid in cash along with respective months salary.

5. (i) Dearness Allowance at increased rate of 59% from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2003 shall be payable in cash w.e.f 1.4.2004 i.e salary for the month of March 2004 payable on 1.4.2004.

(ii) The amount of arrears of D.A. for the period from 01.07.2003 to 29.02.2004 will be paid as follows :-


a) in respect of employees drawing basic pay upto Rs. 10500/- per month (Rs. 3500/- per month for those employees who opt to retain the existing scale of pay), the arrears may be paid in cash in three installments as mentioned below :-

<u>Period</u>	<u>To be paid in</u>
1.07.2003 to 30.09.2003	May 2004 (after 15 <sup>th</sup> )
1.10.2003 to 31.12.2003	June 2004 (after 15 <sup>th</sup> )
1.01.2004 to 29.02.2004	July 2004 (after 15 <sup>th</sup> )

b) In respect of employees drawing basic pay above Rs. 10500/- per month the arrears may be credited to their GPF account or invested in PPF/NSC as per authorisation in 3( three) installments as indicated at (a) above .

5. The increased D.A shall also be admissible & paid in cash to those employees of AVVNL, who were in service on or after 1.1.2003 but whose services were terminated prior to the issue of this order, whether for disciplinary reasons or on account of resignation, retirement, death or discharge or abolition of sanctioned post.
6. The payment of DA will also be subject to the terms & conditions laid down in the Rules of drawl of DA given in Appendix XVI of the R.S.R Vol.II.
