

CIRCULAR

It has been observed that for vehicles declared obsolete/unserviceable, while depositing them in stores for auction, it is not ensured by the concerned field officers that due tax is deposited upto the date the vehicle is on road and documents surrendered from the date the vehicle is off the road.

Such lack of prudence on the part of the field officers poses difficulty in auction of such vehicles. It is, therefore, necessary for the controlling officer of the vehicle that tax is timely deposited for the vehicle till it is on the road. When the vehicle becomes off road and it is not possible to get the vehicle repaired or repair is likely to take time for one reason or other, immediate action to surrender the documents to the concerned Transport authority is taken and necessary confirmation is obtained from the concerned authority about the documents having been surrendered.
