ORDER**Sub:- Grant of Dearness Allowance to the Employees.**

In exercise of the powers conferred vide order No. JPD/CAO/F.246/D.4221 dated 11.12.2001, the Managing Director has been pleased to adopt the State Government's order No. F.1(1)/FD(Rules)/98 dated 14.10.2004 (copy enclosed) and to order that the existing rate of Dearness Allowance payable to the employees, as per order No. JPD/CAO/Rules/F. 247/D.292 dated 11.5.2004, shall be revised w.e.f. 1.7.2004, as under:-

(i) Out of 61% Dearness Allowance -- referred in the above order dated 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2004, 50% has been treated as Dearness pay w.e.f. 1.7.2004 and remaining 11% of Dearness Allowance shall be admissible on Basic Pay as per Order No. JPD/CAO/Rules/sF.99/D.688 dated 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2004.

(ii) Dearness Allowance @ 3% w.e.f. 1.7.2004 shall be admissible on the total of Basic Pay plus Dearness Pay.

The term "Basic Pay" for the purpose of calculation of Dearness Allowance shall be the pay as defined in Regulation 3(xviii) (a) of Employees Service Regulations drawn in the Revised Pay Scale prescribed vide erstwhile RSEB's Order No. RSEB/F&R/F.46(21) (iii)/D.11 dated 24.2.1998, as amended from time to time, and shall not include any other type(s) of pay like special pay or personal pay, etc. In case of those employees who are drawing pay in the existing scale of pay, it will include, in addition to pay in the pre-revised scale, Dearness Allowance and interim relief appropriate to that pay admissible under orders in existence on 1.1.1996.


The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving fraction of 50 paise and above may be rounded off to the next higher rupees and the fractions of less than 50 paise may be ignored.

The Dearness Allowance at increased rate i.e. from 61% to 64% as above, for December, 2004 (payable in January, 2005) and onwards shall be payable in cash alongwith respective month's salary. Orders regarding payment of arrear of Dearness Allowance from July, 04 to November, 04 will be issued, separately.

The payment of Dearness Allowance will also be subject to the terms and conditions laid down in the Rules for drawal of D.A. given in Appendix XVI of the R.S.R. Vol. II.


The increased Dearness Allowance shall also be admissible and paid in cash to those employees who were in service on or after 1.7.2004 but ceased to be in services prior to the issue of this order, whether for disciplinary reasons or on account of resignation, retirement, death or discharge or abolition of sanctioned post.
