ORDER**Sub:- Grant of Dearness Relief to the Pensioners of Jaipur Discom.**

In exercise of the powers conferred vide order No. JPD/CAO/F.246/D.4221 dated 11.12.2001, the Managing Director has been pleased to adopt the State Govt. order No. 15(1)FD(Rules)/98 dated 19.4.2005 regarding - Grant of Dearness Relief to State Government Pensioners for application in respect of pensioners of Jaipur Discom from 64% to 67% w.e.f. 1.1.2005. The provisions of this order shall also be applicable to the pensioners of erstwhile RSEB.

Dearness Relief to the pensioners of Jaipur Discom was increased from 59% to 61% w.e.f. 1.1.2004 vide order No. JPD/CAO/Rules/F.219/D.501 dated 2.6.2004. Out of this 61% Dearness Relief, 50% Dearness Relief has been treated as Dearness pension and rest 11% Dearness Relief was allowed on Pension/Family Pension as per order No. JPD/CAO/Rules/F.99/D.688 dated 19th June, 2004 (JPD/Rules-115). In case of employees retired/retiring on or after 1.7.2004, 11% Dearness Relief is to be calculated on the basis of two third of Basic pension as illustrated below:-

Example of calculation of Pension and Dearness Relief of an employee retiring on or after 1.7.2004 on an assumed Basic Pay of Rs. 10,000/- shall be as:-

(a)	Basic pay of	Rs. 10,000/-
(b)	50% D.A. on basic pay	Rs. 5,000/-
(c)	Emoluments	Rs. 15,000/-
(d)	Pension @ 50% of emoluments for 33 years qualifying service	Rs. 7,500/-
(e)	Dearness Relief @ 11% on two third of basic pension i.e. 5,000/-	Rs. 550/-


Note:- In the aforesaid case further increase in Dearness Relief, if any, will be calculated on pension of Rs. 7,500/-

Dearness Relief @ 3% as indicated in order No. JPD/CAO/Rules/F.259/D.1959 dated 30.11.2004 shall be revised from 3% to 6% w.e.f. 1.1.2005 and it shall be admissible on the total of Pension/Family Pension and Dearness Pension.

The amount of Dearness Relief at increased rates for the month of June, 2005 and onwards shall be payable alongwith the pension for respective month. The payment of arrears of Dearness relief from 1.1.2005 to 31.5.2005 (5 months) shall be paid with the pension for the month of June, 2005 (payable in July, 2005).


