ORDER

In pursuance to the RERC tariff order dated 08.08.2012 and order No.JVVNL/CMD/SE©/D.1345 dated 30/08/2012 (JPR5-657), issued by the Chief Engineer (CP&L), Jaipur Discom, Jaipur, following instructions are hereby issued in the light of "Tariff for Supply of Electricity-2012", for strict compliance by all concerned:-

1. The "Tariff for Supply of Electricity-2012 has come in to force w.e.f. 10-08-2012, accordingly the first bill to be issued as per this tariff will be on prorata consumption basis, for the meter reading taken on or after 10.08.2012.
2. "Farm House" connections, being billed under tariff code 4700, 4710, 4711, 4800, 4810, & 4811 at present have been transferred to domestic category. With a view to identify and correct billing of such consumers, new tariff codes are hereby allotted as under:-

Supply on	LT	HT	HT
Metering on	LT	LT	HT
Tariff code	1800	1810	1811

The billing agencies will transfer the above consumers to newly allotted tariff codes (i.e. 4700&4800 to 1800, 4710&4810 to 1810, and 4711&4811 to 1811) and also provide a list of such consumers with account number, name, address and connected load etc., for further verification by the Sub-division.

3. Each farm house connection will be checked & verified by the unit officer, promptly. On checking, if it is found that energy of the farm house connection is not being utilized for bonafide domestic use, the unit officer and ARO will transfer such connections to respective tariff codes prescribed under NDS category, providing input advice-2A, to the billing agency. They will also be responsible for debit of undercharges relating to previous period if any, simultaneously.
4. **Wedding house connections being billed under tariff code 2300, 2320, 2310 & 2311 are to be treated equally at par with other non-domestic consumers, for release of connection and application of tariff . As such, tariff codes 2300, 2320, 2310 & 2311 is hereby withdrawn with immediate effect. Further, such consumers will be transferred by the billing agencies to the respective non domestic tariff codes, as under :-**

5. At present, lighting connections of public parks are being billed under PSL/LT-3 whereas pumping sets of public gardens belonging to the Government / Local Bodies are being billed under Agriculture Service. Since the aforesaid connections have now been categorized under the tariff schedule ML/LT-7, the unit officers will immediately identify such connections and transfer such connections to the respective tariff codes prescribed under Mixed Load category, providing input advice-2A, to the billing agency. They will also be responsible for debiting of undercharges of previous period if any, simultaneously.
6. Radio Stations, Television Stations and their Transmitters are presently being billed under tariff schedule ML/LT-7. Since all such connections have now been transferred under the tariff schedule NDS/LT-2, the unit officers will immediately identify such connections and transfer such connections to the respective tariff codes under Non-Domestic category, providing input advice-2A, to the billing agency. They will also be responsible for debiting of undercharges of previous period if any, simultaneously.
7. The agriculture consumers (metered & flat rate, both) have now been categorized under two sub categories only. The first one is general and getting supply in block hours whereas the second is applicable for the remaining consumers not covered under the general category and also for the consumers getting more than block hour supply. The field officers will therefore ensure correct application of tariff, accordingly.
8. Instead of load based tariff under SP/LT-5, slab based energy charges will be applicable on the units consumed.
9. The Medium Industrial Consumers having supply on LT may also opt to be billed on demand basis. As such, provisions applicable for charging of the fixed charges and demand surcharge to MP/HT-3 consumers shall also apply to such consumers.
The above order shall come into force from the date of implementation of "tariff-2012" (10/08/2012).
