

ORDER

With the introduction of new tariff schedule DS/HT-1, NDS/HT-2, MP/HT-3 and ML/HT-4 in part II of Tariff for Supply of Electricity - 2004 and in view of clarification issued by the Commercial Wing vide their order No.JPD/CE(C)/C.I/F.4(251)/Pt.II/D.323 dt.22.2.2005 (JPR-5/255), billing of aforesaid categories of consumers will be done in accordance with the instructions, mentioned hereunder:-

- i) All consumers covered under tariff schedule DS/HT-1, NDS/HT-2, MP/HT-3 and ML/HT-4 and having supply on HT are to be billed as per provisions contained in their respective tariff schedule. In case, consumers have not yet stipulated their contract demand, sanctioned connected load of the consumer shall be taken as his contract demand
- ii) Transformation losses @ 3% would only be applicable on such consumers to whom energy is being supplied on HT but metering is on LT side. Transformer rent would also be applicable where a consumer takes Nigam's Transformer on rent and advice 3E is to be sent by the sub-division concerned, to the computer agency accordingly.
- iii) Some consumers under the categories NDS/LT-2, MP/LT-6 & ML/LT-7, having supply on LT but are being billed on demand basis due to exceeding their maximum demand more than 50 KVA, a notice of one month asking the consumer to take supply on HT & to stipulate his contract demand shall be issued by the concerned AEN failing which their supply would be disconnected, such notice period may however be extended by the M.D. During the intervening period billing shall be carried out in accordance with the provisions contained in part I of their respective LT tariff i.e. they are to be billed on connected load basis. Transformer rent and transformation losses would not be applicable on such consumers.
- iv) If maximum demand of the LT consumers covered in Part I exceeds beyond 50 KVA third time in the same financial year a notice of one month asking the consumer to take supply on HT & to stipulate his contract demand shall be issued by the concerned AEN failing which their supply would be disconnected, such notice period may however be extended by the M.D. During the intervening period billing shall be carried out in accordance with the provisions contained in part I of their respective LT tariff i.e. they are to be billed on connected load basis. Transformer rent and transformation losses would not be applicable on such consumers.

Since above instructions are effective on the consumption of 1.1.2005 or thereafter, the computer agency would reprocess the earlier billing (Feb.05) and would allow necessary debit/credit in consumers account accordingly.


