22ndCIRCULAR

1. The Board in its 19th meeting held on 16.02.2002 decided to waive off delayed payment surcharge levied on electricity dues payable by Urban Local Bodies provided the Local Bodies undertake timely payment of current energy charges. The outstanding dues so computed be equated in six equal installments for recovery.
2. Large number of local bodies are also raising House Tax on the premises of the Vitran Nigam for which an application be filed before the House Tax Committee/Chairman/Executive Officer for proper computation/ claims of arrears towards House Tax. Such claims as mutually decided be adjusted against the outstanding dues.
3. Should there be any problem/dispute with Nagar Nigam regarding outstanding dues, the concerned District Collector may be contacted for amicable settlement of dues for which he is being separately requested. It is, therefore, advised to take immediate steps to recover the outstanding dues from the local bodies.
