
ORDER

It was pointed out in the meeting of Vigilance Officers held on 18th May, 02 that Circle Accounts Officers are not arranging payment of their incentive claims for want of budget.

Budgetary provision is generally a pre-requisite to fund the specific item of expenditure but in case of incentive claims, the same are paid for after the additional revenue as a result of vigilance checking/detection of theft etc. is realized. The incentive bills are therefore self funded from budget point of view and so budget should be no constraint in entertaining the incentive bills.

Circle Accounts Officers are therefore advised to take necessary action accordingly while entertaining the incentive claims. However, necessary provision would be sought in budget estimates/revised budget estimates by the field officers including vigilance offices so that fair assessment of likely expenditure on this account is reflected in the budget of the Nigam.
