Sub : Dis-connection of temporary connections.

It has been noticed that temporary connections released for a specific period remain continue without extension being sought by the consumers. This results in such consumers using energy but payment in lieu of energy consumption is not received to Nigam's account. This is clear negligence on the part of concerned officers. Unless extension is requested by the consumer temporary connection should be removed on the date on which the period is over. As per GCOS, temporary supply will be given for a period not exceeding one month in the first instance but the supply can be extended for a further period not exceeding one month on each occasion after collecting additional deposits to cover the anticipated consumption for extended period(s), subject to maximum of 3 months over all for any one consumer. It has also been mentioned that meter reading for Temporary supply will be taken at the end of each fortnight or at the end of each period but atleast once in a month.


It is, therefore, necessary for all concerned that strict compliance of the provisions as contained in GCOS is made and temporary supply should be discontinued as and when the time period is over . In any case, there should be no outstanding dues against temporary connections and on estimated basis, amount for consumption should be recovered in advance to cover the energy consumption by a temporary consumer. A ledger for all temporary connections should be maintained in each Sub-div. and it should be closely monitored by the AEN as well as ARO.
