ORDER

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III. In the Schedule-II appended to the said regulations, the existing para 6 as appearing under serial no. F is substituted by the following:-

"To become eligible for consideration for appointment, candidates shall be required to secure minimum passing marks in each Phase as detailed below in the written competitive exams :-


