TN-SC-21 (Vehicle)

1. Average annual financial turnover in the preceding three complete financial year as on date of bid opening should not be less then **Rs. 20.09 lakhs** for this purpose any one of the following documents may be submitted:-

2. In case ESI registration and labour license are not available with the participating bidder/firm, then they are required to furnish an undertaking on non judicial stamp paper of Rs.=100/- stating that the required registration shall be obtained by them and furnished to RVUN within one month after placement of LOI.
5. The Bidder should be owner of at least one number of commercial/taxi permit Bus (AC).

In case work awarded by RVUNL performance certificate issue on or after 06.01.2017 should be signed by Chief Engineer/Incharge of Power Station/ Project.

4. The participating bidders should have GSTIN registration, PF registration, PAN card, ESI registration and labour licence (if required). In case ESI registration and labour license are not available with the participating bidder/firm, then they are required to furnish an undertaking on non judicial stamp paper of Rs.=100/- stating that the required registration shall be obtained by them and furnished to RVUN within one month after placement of LOI.

Only those firms can participate, who possess the following pre-qualifying requirements and shall have to submit necessary documents along with tender.

1. Financial QR: -

Average Annual Turnover (AAT) of the participating bidder during preceding three (03) financial years as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening, shall not be less than **Rs.2.47 Crores**. Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover.

Note: -Bidder shall submit/furnish duly certified audited balance sheet and profit & loss account statement/Annual report or duly certified certificate from practicing CA showing the details of Average Annual Turnover of preceding three (03) financial years as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening, to adjudge Average Annual Turnover criteria.

2. Technical QR: -

The bidder should have executed the **similar work** in India during the preceding seven (07) years reckoned as on the date of techno commercial bid opening having:

(A) Executed values not less than **Rs1.98 Crores** in single **Contract**

OR

(B) Executed values not less than **Rs1.24 Crores** in Two **Contracts** in each.

OR

(C) Executed values not less than **Rs0.99 Crores** in Three**Contracts** in each.

Similar works means either of the following:

(a) The bidder must have **executed** Annual Maintenance Contract of Boiler Pressure Parts and its Auxiliaries of coal based Thermal Power Plant of 250 MW unit or above capacity units during last seven (07) years.

OR

(b) The bidder must have **executed** erection and commissioning of at least one Boiler Pressure Parts of Coal Based Thermal Power Plant of 500MW unit or above capacity units in last 7

years in combined or separate contracts reckoned as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening.

OR

- (c) OEM/OES of SG & its Auxiliaries Packages of 500MW or above capacity units of coal based thermal power plant shall be deemed /considered to have met Technical Criteria stipulated in qualifying Requirements of this work. However, in case they bid for the Tender, they shall have to qualify Financial Criteria stipulated in this Qualifying Requirements. They will submit all relevant documents in support of above.

4. Satisfactory performance certificate or satisfactory work completion certificate for above work executed by the firm issued by the owner/ order placing authorities shall be submitted. In case work awarded by RVUNL, performance certificate issued on or after Dt. 06.01.2017 should be signed by Chief Engineer/ In-charge of Power Station/ Project.
5. The bidder should submit an undertaking on Non judicial stamp paper worth rupees 100/- with the certificate mentioning in it that the firm has no liability in the concern department regarding deposition of CPF, ESI, Service tax/GST etc. up to the preceding financial year.

TN-SC-24 (Turbine)

Only those firms can participate, who possess the following pre-qualifying requirements and shall have to submit necessary documents along with tender.

1. Financial QR:-

Average Annual Turnover (AAT) of the participating bidder during preceding three (03) financial years as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening, shall not be less than Rs. **80.95 lacs**. Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover.

Note:- Bidder shall submit/furnish duly certified audited balance sheet and profit & loss account statement/Annual report or duly certified certificate from practicing CA showing the details of Average Annual Turnover of preceding three (03) financial years as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening, to adjudge Average Annual Turnover criteria.

2. Technical QR:-

The bidder should have executed the **similar work** in India during the preceding seven (07) years reckoned as on the date of techno commercial bid opening having:

- A. Executed value not less than 80% of the estimated cost (Rs.64.76 Lac) in a Single Contract.

OR

B. Executed value not less than 50% of the estimated cost (Rs.40.48 Lac) in Two Contracts each.

OR

C. Executed value not less than 40% of the estimated cost (Rs.32.38 Lac) in Three Contracts each.

Similar works means either of the following:

a) The bidder must have **executed** Complete maintenance Contract of steam turbine of 250 MW or above capacity units in last seven (07) years reckoned as on the date of techno- commercial bid opening. For the purpose of evaluation, annual maintenance contract of Steam turbine and its auxiliaries put together and executed in any consecutive 12 months period shall be treated as One Contract even if these are executed as separate contracts.

OR

b) The bidder must have executed erection and commissioning of at least One steam turbine of 500MW or above in last 7 years in combined or separate contracts reckoned as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening.

OR

c) OEM/OES of Steam Turbine& its Auxiliaries Packages of 500MW or above capacity units shall be deemed /considered to have met Technical Criteria stipulated in qualifying Requirements of this work. However, in case they bid for the Tender, they shall have to qualify Financial Criteria stipulated in this Qualifying Requirements. They will submit all relevant documents in support of above.

NOTE 1:

The word "executed" means the bidder should have achieved the criterion specified in QR, even if the total contract is not completed/closed. Payment receipt document with reference to WO No. and date or work execution certificate with executed value and referred order no. & date from the Owner to this effect that the job to this extent has been done by the Bidder satisfactorily may also be considered as a proof of execution even if the work has not been completed in totality (subject to furnishing proof of executed value of work in the form of certified copies of RA Bills) or any relevant documents, which is sufficient to prove the works completed or to be completed. The same shall be supported by documentary evidence issued by the owner.

- I) In case where audited results (Balance Sheets and Profit & Loss Statement) for the preceding three (03) financial year are not available, certification of financial statements from a practicing Chartered Accountant shall also be considered acceptable.

- III) The participating bidders should have GST registration with Central Excise Department, PF registration, PAN card, ESI registration, labour license and electrical license. If any of the above presently is not available with them, then they will have to furnish an undertaking to the effect that same shall be furnished within one month from issue of LOI.
- IV) Satisfactory performance certificate or satisfactory work completion certificate for above work executed by the firm issued by the owner/order placing authorities. In case work awarded by RVUNL, performance certificate issued on or after Dt. 06.01.2017 should be signed by the Chief Engineer/In-charge of Power Station/Project.

- V) The bidder should submit and under taking on non judicial stamp paper worth Rs. 100/- with the certificate mentioning in it that the firm has no liability in the concerned department regarding deposition of CPF, ESI, Service tax/ GST etc. up to the preceding financial year.

The technical evaluation of the bids shall be done on the basis of above criterions. The offer of the bidder not full filing above criterions fully are likely to be ignored.

TN-SC-25 (Electrical)

Only those firms can participate, who possess the following prequalifying requirements and shall have to submit necessary documents along with tender.

1. Financial QR:

Average annual financial turnover in the preceding three complete financial years as on date of bid opening should not be less than **Rs21.00 Lac**. For this purpose, any one of the following documents may be submitted: -

- (iv) Audited Balance sheet of last three financial years.
- (v) Annual Return filed with IT Deptt/ TDS certificate of last three financial years.
- (vi) Copies of work order executed.

2. Technical QR:

The Bidder must have an experience of having successfully executed /completed the contract for similarnature of work in India i.e. Annual contract for routine/breakdown & annual maintenance of Generator & its auxiliaries of 250 MW or more in any coal based thermal power plant(s) during the preceding seven(07) years reckoned as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening, having:

- (c) Executed value not less than 80% of estimated cost(Rs. 16.8 Lac) in a single contract
OR

- (d) Executed value not less than 50% of estimated cost(Rs. 10.5 Lac) in a two contracts each.
OR

- (e) Executed value not less than 40% of estimated cost(Rs. 8.40 Lac) in three contracts each.

Similar works means either of the following:

The bidder must have executed complete maintenance contract of Generator of 250 MW or above capacity units in last seven (7) years reckoned as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening. For the purpose of evaluation, one annual maintenance contract of Generator & its auxiliaries put together and executed in any consecutive 12 months period shall be treated as one contract even if these are executed as separate contracts.

OR

The bidder must have executed erection and commissioning of at least one Generator of 500 MW or above in last seven (7) years in combined or separate contracts reckoned as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening.

OR

OEM/OES of Generator and its auxiliaries package of 500 MW units and above shall be deemed/ considered to have met technical criteria stipulated in qualifying requirements of this work. They will submit relevant documents in support of above i.e. work order/purchase order. However, in case they bid for the tender, they shall have to qualify financial criteria stipulated in this qualifying requirements.

In support of above, bidder shall furnish documentary evidence, copies of work order along with Satisfactory performance certificate or satisfactory work completion certificate for the above work executed by the firm issued by the owner/order placing authorities. In case work awarded by RVUNL, performance certificate issued on or after 06.01.2017 should be signed by Chief Engineer/Incharge of Power Station/ Project.

Note 1: - The word “executed” means the bidder should have achieved the criterion specified in QR, even if the total contract is not completed/closed. Payment receipt document with reference to WO No. and date or work execution certificate with executed value and referred order no. & date from the Owner to this effect that the job to this extent has been done by the Bidder satisfactorily may also be considered as a proof of execution even if the work has not been completed in totality (subject to furnishing proof of executed value of work in the form of certified copies of RA Bills) or any relevant documents, which is sufficient to prove the works completed or to be completed. If any of the above license are not available with the participating bidder/firm presently, then they are required to furnish an undertaking on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.=100/- stating that the required registration shall be obtained by them and submit to RVUN within one month after placement of LOI.
4. The bidder should submit an undertaking on Non Judicial Stamp paper worth rupees 100/- with the certificate mentioning in it that the firm has no liability in the concerned department regarding deposition of CPF, ESI. Service Tax/GST etc. up to the preceding financial year.

The technical evaluation of the bids shall be done on the basis of above criterions. The offers of the bidder not fulfilling above criterions fully are likely to be ignored.

- C. The bidder will have to register themselves on website <http://www.eproc.rajasthan.gov.in> for participating in this tender. For this purpose Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) have to be obtained from any agency approved by CCA. This DSC will be used to sign the bids submitted online by the bidder. Unsigned tenders will not be entertained and will be rejected out rightly.
- D. The tender for works shall remain open for acceptance for the period of 180 days from the date of opening of pre-qualification/ technical bid or up to such period as detailed out in tender document.
- E. If any tenderer withdraws his tender prior to expiry of validity period as mentioned at S. No. 5 or mutually extended period or makes modifications in the rates, terms and conditions of the tender within the said validity period, which are not acceptable to the department, or fails to commence the work in the specified period/ fails to execute the agreement, the department shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy be at liberty to forfeit the amount of earnest money given in any form absolutely. If any contractor, who having submitted a tender does not execute the agreement or start the work or does not complete the work and the work has to be put to re-tendering, he shall stand debarred from participating in such re-tendering in addition to forfeiture of earnest money/ security deposit and other action under agreement. If there is strong justification of believing that the tenderer or his authorized has been guilty of mal-practices such as submission of forged documents, influencing individually or politically, his offer will be liable to rejection and in such case his earnest money shall be forfeited.

- K. The acceptance of the tender will rest with the competent authority who does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender, and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without assigning any reason.

- M. All other conditions shall be prevailing as detailed out in the departmental tender document (in the respective sections/ volumes).
